The Spanish Association for the Energy Economics (AEEE) announces the celebration of the XIV AEEE Annual Conference on January 31 and February 1, 2019 in A Coruña. The Rectorate Building of the University of A Coruña will host the most important academic and business conference on Energy Economics in Spain.

The AEEE is the Spanish division of the International Association for Energy Economics (IAEE) and, among its activities, promotes the organization of an annual Conference on Energy Economics. The Conference of the AEEE intends to promote the links between the university, regulators and companies with interests in areas such as Energy Economics, Environment and Climate Change. In this fourteenth edition, the main theme of the Conference is "**Energy transition, industry and employment**". This topic tries to cover the main challenge, in the medium term, of high quality job creation by searching for opportunities and solutions within the industry, and in the context of a fair energy transition towards a decarbonized economy. It is, therefore, a matter of thinking about what alternatives can be offered for the electricity and energy business in order to achieve a sustainable environmental and socioeconomic future. The focus will be on the Iberian, the European and the global framework.

For all this, the Conference offers academic participation through the presentation of papers and / or posters in parallel sessions, as well as plenary lectures and a round table with business, social, political and academic representatives of the highest level. The papers and / or posters will be selected after a peer review process).

Guide for authors: PAPER submission

The Scientific Committee and the Organizing Committee invite all researchers to send their original works (theoretical and / or empirical) on any research area in the field of Energy Economics, including the central theme of this edition, **before November 30th, 2018**. Papers will be evaluated and, where appropriate, accepted for presentation at the parallel sessions of the Conference.

Each accepted communication must be presented by one speaker. In order to reinforce the mutual knowledge of the works and to facilitate the organization of the Conference, each speaker accepts the task of commenting his/her work on the Parallel Session.

The submission will consist on a single file in PDF format, with a maximum size of 2MB, to the e-mail address: **aeee@aeee.es**. The name of the .pdf file will follow the following model: "Surname_Name_Brief title.pdf".

The first page should include the following information: name, affiliation and email address of the author and co-authors; Work title; abstract of no more than 100 words; 3 JEL codes and a maximum of 5 key words.

The papers will be subject to revision process by the Scientific Committee.

Guide for authors: POSTER submission

The Scientific Committee and the Organizing Committee invite all researchers to send their original poster on any research area in the field of Energy Economics, including the central theme of this edition, **before November 30th, 2018**. Papers will be evaluated and, where appropriate, accepted for presentation at the parallel sessions of the Conference.

Participants will have the opportunity to present their work in a specific “Poster Session” and get feedback from the audience. Only registered participants will be able to present their posters at the Conference.

If you are interested in presenting a poster, please send an e-mail to aeee@aeee.es. Writing on the Subject of the e-mail: POSTER SUBMISSION. The e-mail information will be: Authors’ name and surname, affiliation, Title and Abstract. And, please, attach a “.pdf” file with the poster, with the following name: “Poster_Surname_Name.pdf” (Max. Dimension: 120cm x 90cm). The deadline for posters submission is **November 30th, 2018**.

The AEEE Conference Scientific Committee will evaluate the poster applications. The decision will be communicated to authors by December 20th, 2018. Only accepted posters will be presented at the “Posters Session” of the Conference. Each Poster speaker will have 7 minutes to present it.

RESEARCH PROJECTS Session

If you are participating in a Research Project and want to present its results or simply explain what your group is researching and how you are doing it, you just have to send a page with the following information: name of the Project, funding entity, Coordinator-Principal investigator of the project, affiliation, e-mail address of the applicant, and an “Abstract” -of no more than 500 words- describing the project as well as the possibility of having possible collaborations with other researchers, **before November 30th, 2018 (deadline)**.

The submission will consist of a single file in .pdf format sending to the e-mail address: aeee@aeee.es. The name of the file in pdf will follow the following model: “Session Projects_Name of the project.pdf”.

The proposals will be subject to evaluation process by the Scientific Committee. Accepted projects may present it at the Session reserved for it in the Conference. Notifications of acceptance will be communicated on December 20th, 2018. The applicant must prepare a Poster that summarizes the Project and which would serve to present it and to look for possible future collaborations. It is necessary to register as a participant in the Conference to be able to present it.

Papers’ Dissemination

The text of the communications will be delivered to the participants in a Minutes Book or similar electronic format. Communications will also be included in a repository of exclusive access for members on the Association's website. Authors who submit their works accept that they be disseminated through these channels.

On the website of the association (www.aeee.es) and on the Conference website (http://www.aeee.es/xiv_congreso_aeee/), can be updated information about the Conference, accommodation options, venue will be provided of events and final program.

Registration and fees

At least one author of each accepted communication or poster must pay the registration fee and attend the Conference to present the work. The fees will entitle the documentation, the coffees, the meals and the gala dinner.

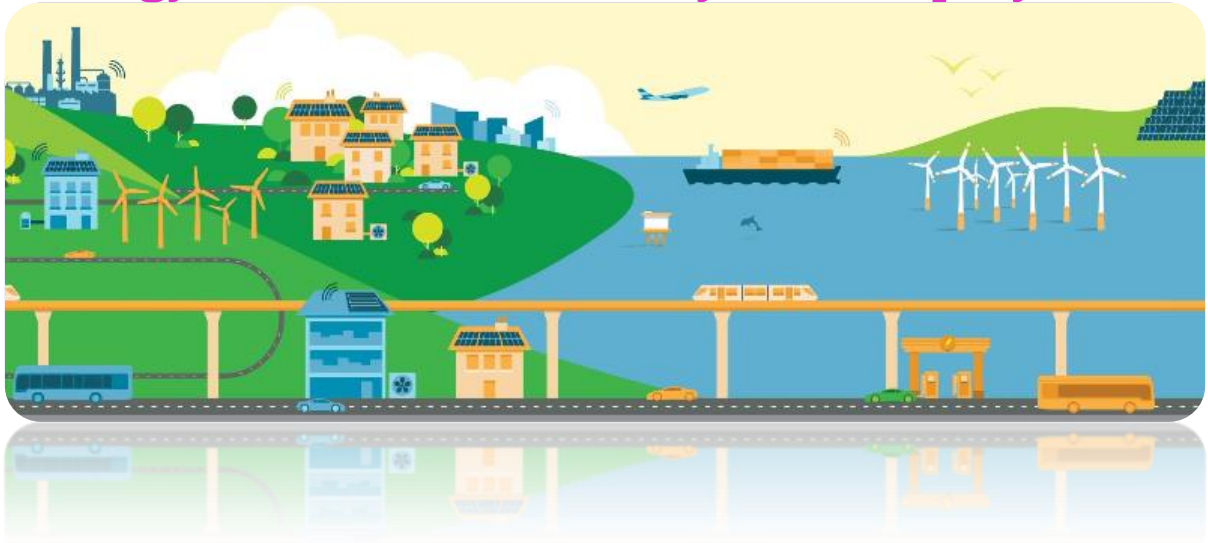
